## **Information Update**

## **North Hill Retaining Wall Construction Works**

Dear Resident or Business,

We write to inform you that will be resuming the construction works on North Hill Retaining Wall week commencing 18 May. Following the temporary suspension of works, the expected completion date will be December 2020.

To accommodate the construction works, we will reinstate the previous restrictions that were in place prior to the suspension of works last month. As a reminder these are as follows:

- North Hill will become northbound only for vehicular traffic between View Road and the North Hill Avenue.
- Bus routes 143 & 603, southbound direction only, will be on diversion through Archway Road.
- All residents' parking bays between View Road and North Hill Avenue (including the ones
  on the service road and north of the pelican crossing), will be suspended for the duration of
  works
- No vehicular access to the Service Road between View Road and Storey Road.
- Storey Road will remain open to vehicular traffic, however, we will require full closure of Storey Road when the resurfacing work/junction modification works are carried out. We will send out information letters in advance to inform all residents of the closure dates. For clarity, the closures are envisaged to be of short duration - less than a day at the time.
- Pedestrian access and emergency vehicle access to all properties will always be maintained.

Further to the above, we will also be suspending the parking bays on one side of Church Road (North Side) between North Hill and Talbot Road; this is to ease the congestion and remove the "bottleneck" as a result of increase of traffic expected on Church Road.

The waste collection will remain as it is currently. However, we do request that residents on the Service Road leave their waste bags and recycling in a clearly visible location within their property and close to the road to help collections by the waste service.
